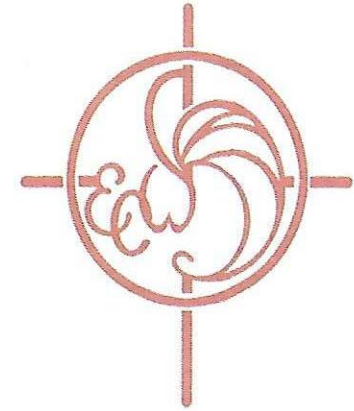

Directions and Parking

Traveling **east** on **I-86** (Rt 17) take exit 7 toward Panama/Chautauqua Institution; turn left onto Rt 33; follow Rt 33 about 4 miles, and turn right onto West Lake Road (Rt 394). Chautauqua Institution will be on your left in less than a mile.

Traveling **west** on **I-86** (Rt 17) take exit 8 toward Mayville/Lakewood, and turn right onto West Lake Road (Rt 394). Chautauqua Institution will be on your right in a few miles.

Enter the Institution through the South Gate; turn right, and follow South Avenue to the parking lot next to a large building with columns also on your right.

If the South Gate is closed, use the Main Gate and turn right onto Massey Ave, then turn left onto South Ave and follow to the parking lot.

From the parking lot, follow the red brick path, past the Hall of Philosophy to the Episcopal Cottage, located on your right at the corner of Peck Avenue.
