“The King of Love” is the most beautiful of all renditions of the Twenty-Third Psalm. It was written by Henry Williams Baker, born in London in 1821. He attended Trinity College, Cambridge, and was ordained at age 24.

Henry worked for years on a “book of hymns that would reflect the grandeur of majestic worship.” The first edition was published in 1861 and was called Hymns Ancient and Modern. It became the leading hymnbook in the Anglican church. “The King of Love” appeared in the 1868 revision.

When Henry passed away in 1877, a friend reported that his last words were from this hymn:

“Perverse and foolish oft I strayed, But yet in love He sought me,  
And on His shoulder gently laid, And home, rejoicing, brought me.”
