Our offertory hymn for today is #657, "Love Divine, All Loves Excelling." It was written by Charles Wesley in 1747. The hymn is based on this scripture: His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue. 2 Peter 1:3.

Charles inherited a gift for poetry from his father. A biographer says about his poetry: "He had within him virtually a treasury of poetry. He constantly experienced the emotions of the true poet, his mind instinctively invested words with harmony, and hymn after hymn flowed from his pen."

Charles wrote somewhere between three thousand and six thousand hymns. "Love divine, All Loves Excelling" is the favorite of many.
