He Touched Me

Shackled by a heavy burden, 'Neath a load of guilt and shame; Then the hand of Jesus touched me, And now I am no longer the same.

Refrain:

He touched me, oh, He touched me, And oh, the joy that floods my soul! Something happened, and now I know He touched me and made me whole.

Since I met this blessed Savior, Since He cleansed and made me whole, I will never cease to praise Him; I'll shout it while eternity rolls. (Refrain)

Bill Gaither wrote the words and melody for "He Touched me" in 1964. Bill was an English teacher who co-wrote songs with his wife, an English and French teacher. They spent evenings and weekends writing songs and then handed out copies of their songs at choir rehearsal.

Returning home after an evangelistic service, a preacher friend, Dr. Dale Oldham, suggested Bill write a song about "how wonderfully the Lord can touch and heal a person's life." Dr. Dale said "Bill there's something special about that word touch. You ought to write a song about how God touches lives."

That night Bill wrote the lyrics to two verses and the chorus and also composed the melody. "He Touched Me" has been recorded by many of the greatest names in the music industry including by Elvis Presley.
