“Holy, Holy, Holy! Lord God Almighty,” a traditional opening hymn for Trinity Sunday, was written by Reginald Heber in 1826 while he was a parish priest in an English village.

Then Sings My Soul states: “He sought to lift the literary quality of hymns, and he also dreamed of publishing a collection of high-caliber hymns corresponding to the church year for use by liturgical churches.”

Heber wrote 57 hymns while he was a parish priest but these hymns were not published until after his death.

This hymn is based on Revelation 4:8: “And they do not rest day or night, saying: ‘Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!’”

From Then Sings My Soul written by Robert J. Morgan
